

Medicare vaccination administration and the change for your pharmacy

Managed Care

As the billing requirements move from Medicare Part B to Part D for vaccinations, please be aware of the transition policy and the opportunity available to you **NOW**, for 2008 and beyond.

Requirements:

- Pharmacy must have an NPI number
 - Pharmacy must be a Part B provider
 - Patient must be enrolled in a Part D plan
- Billing code for 2007 - *G0377: Administration of vaccine for Part B drug*
 - Payment under Part B will only be available if vaccine is furnished
 - Vaccine itself must be billed to Part D
 - Pharmacy must accept assignment and must keep physician orders on file
 - Pharmacy must bill - not patient
 - Bill through ANSI 837 or CMS 1500 form
